

The Intersection of Technocracy and Totalitarianism

A Special Interview With Patrick Wood

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Welcome everyone, this is Dr. Mercola helping you take control of your health, and today we are fortunate enough to be joined by Patrick Wood, who I just saw his interview with The Defender, or the Children's Health Defense, and it was really, we're going to put a copy of that video in this page that we're writing, so I would encourage you to watch that one first, because that gives you a really good background of Patrick and his work.

Even though, I've interviewed him before, that content's not readily available, so we're going to make it easy for you. This is really current. It was good. Then, I saw that video actually last night as we're recording this, and I thought, gosh, it tied in so well with an interview I did earlier this week with Mattias Desmet, which is not going to be aired for a few more weeks.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Patrick's interview is going to come up first, but this really is the issue of the day. There's not many people talking about probably because not many people understand it and the potential implications. Mattias has a really good handle on it. You're going to really enjoy the interview. He wrote a book, "The Psychology of Totalitarianism" and Patrick has done decades of work on technocracy. I'm sure most of you have heard of that before, but Patrick would probably give a little history of that.

One of the motivating factors for me, we're going to get into some of the projections, which I think, the most interesting component, but one of the most interesting perspectives is to differentiate or reconcile the differences between totalitarianism and technocracy because they're two different entities, but they're so similar. I think there's not many people better qualified than Patrick to help enlighten us on that. Welcome with that long introduction, and thank you for joining us today.

Patrick Wood:

That's great. I love to talk about this and I wish there was something else to talk about, but this is it. This is the topic of the day. This is what people need to know and understand. If we are going to fight back against this enemy, which previously has pretty much been unseen, we must recognize who we're dealing with. Period. We cannot deal, we cannot provide any defense or offense to push back on this unless we know who the enemy really is and what they're thinking, what's in their head.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. You've been studying this for a long time. You actually, in that hour[-long] interview from The Defender, you go into how you understood this very early on, like we did too, and we recognized it immediately because we were alert. We had our critical thinking skills involved.

Patrick Wood:

Right.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

You knew it, like that first month or two of January 2020, so you weren't surprised by this at all.

Patrick Wood:

No, I wasn't. That only because I had been following the climate change, global warming alarmism for a long time. That's been part of the wheelhouse for technocracy embedded in the United Nations, the sustainable development, but climate change, global warming has been used as the fear-producing, fearmongering, fear porn, whatever, to drive people insane to make them willing to accept sustainable development as the answer to all the world's problems.

And so, when I saw the same people that were promoting climate alarmism jump track over onto the COVID train, I knew that something was up immediately. I didn't have to know anything about COVID, nothing. I didn't have to know anything about viruses necessarily, but I saw the people who were pushing it all of a sudden, and I realized that the crack computer models that were being used to tell us that we're all going to die.

Patrick Wood:

I can remember what Al Gore said, the seas are going to rise and the polar ice caps are going to melt. That never happened, but all these predictions come rolling out of these crazy computer models that are pretty much rigged to say whatever you wanted to say. They used the same techniques on the pandemic to get it kick started.

Then of course, as some of the details began to unfold from there, the rest of it became really, really clear. Here we are today, two years later, and I claimed at the time, I said, "This is technocracy's coup d'état that they're finally making their major global move to do what they said they were going to do for a long time." But now, they're actually putting shoe leather to it and they're making it happen, so I called it coup d'état early on.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. Yeah. You definitely caught it early. In your interview with The Defender, you quoted your associate and co-writer of many books, Anthony Sutton, who is a major influence for you, certainly in early research in this, in technocracy. You quoted him as saying that only 2% of people have critical thinking skills or can think, 8% of people think they can think, the rest of them can't think at all or something like that.

Patrick Wood:

Yeah, 90% would rather die than think.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Oh, that was it, 90% would rather die. That was really good. I just couldn't recall it. But it's interesting because Mattias comes up with something similar and I was kind of astonished because I didn't think the number was so low, but his assertion is that only 10%, only 1 out of 10 people are not, or still have retained their critical thinking skills, they can think. Thirty percent

are completely hypnotized, completely hypnotized, so much so that they, or someone they love dearly can get the jab die within hours or a few days and believe that was absolutely unrelated to that jab.

Patrick Wood:

Right.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

That's how deeply they're hypnotized. It's just shocking when you look at it because if they had their critical thinking skills, it would be so obvious, but they don't, they lost it. Then the other 60%, somewhere in the middle, they can sway either way, but it's a small group of people that we're speaking to, Patrick.

Patrick Wood:

Yes, it is. It's getting bigger, I have to say, because people that are in that middle group, the fence-sitters, I call them. I think maybe he refers to them a little bit differently, but people kind of have their one toe on this side and the other toe on the other side. They don't know what they think. One day, they'll say one thing, next day, they'll say something else. Most of the people shaking out of that group are falling our way, not the other way, and this is a good thing. This only comes because those people that finally kind of wake up to what's going on, they feel the hand in their back pocket, right? They feel the damage to their bodies. People like Eric Clapton, for instance, just good example, who's always been kind of a rebel.

Patrick Wood:

I wouldn't want to put him in the total mass formation camp, but he succumbed to taking a shot initially. I think he's got boosted after that, but it paralyzed his hands. Now, if people don't know who Clapton is, he's one of the arguably, I think one of the best guitarists on the planet and he's 76 years old now. He unfortunately just got COVID after he's vaccinated, fully vaxxed, but he got COVID anyway. But he lost, his hands were paralyzed and scared the pants off of him. You can imagine, guys, his whole life is wrapped up in his hands.

Patrick Wood:

All of a sudden, he can't play. He figured, "Maybe I'll never play what." In that state, you'd do some thinking, right? And he did some thinking. He says, something's really wrong here. People like that are personally impacted, they really start to change their worldview when they realize, "Hey man, I'm hurting now. It's not my neighbor, not the guy down the streets. Me." And so, some of those people are shaken out. This is finally a good thing. Is it too late, too little? I don't know, but I'm glad to say, it happened.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Well, and so, Mattias says, is that those of us who are in the 10% really need to express their voices. Interestingly, he's convinced that it's better done in person rather than virtually.

Patrick Wood:

I agree.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

We could take a side step because you are in the middle, as we're recording this, of a tour-

Patrick Wood:

Yes.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

-in a live tour. Why don't you tell us a little about that tour and what your experience has been with that?

Patrick Wood:

Yes. I fully identify with what Mattias is saying about meeting in person is different than meeting on Zoom like we are right now. This is really good, but we would have a completely different dynamic, if we're meeting in person. We could see each other in 3D, we could talk, we could touch, whatever. You could hear the vibration of our voices. In the Zoom video, of course, you're losing half the frequency that you would have if we were in person.

There's lots of differences, but Desmet has it right on that. We need to reconnect with other humans, physically, personally, and get away from all the electronic communications and stuff, and just sit down with people across the table and talk to them. But having said that, we have been involved in this Crimes Against Humanity Tour across the nation. There's just four of us who prepared a message. It's a one-day message on stage and-

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Who are the other three?

Patrick Wood:

Well, just give it an order presentation, me first in the morning to set the stage for globalization and what's happening on the global stage. Dr. Judy Mikovits usually goes next.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

She's a favorite.

Patrick Wood:

She brings her eyewitness testimony to what happened with Anthony Fauci and her over the years and stuff. It's very germane right now. Then Dr. Reiner Fuellmich, the international lawyer who has orchestrated the Corona Investigative Committee, as well as the grand jury of public opinion. He's interviewed hundreds of hours now on tape of people, experts from all over the planet. I mean, it's really amazing. Then lastly, Dr. Richard Fleming of Dallas, he is not only

scientist and doctor, but he's also a lawyer. He's got through quite an interesting mix of skills. I don't know how long he went to school for all that, but-

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

That was many years. He was well past 30 when he finished his-

Patrick Wood:

I can imagine, but I'll tell you, he's got a lot to say and so the four of us-

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, smart guy, I've interviewed him before, he's a smart guy.

Patrick Wood:

Yeah. Yeah. The four of us are giving a joint presentation on turning the audience into a grand jury. "Okay, you decide now, we'll give you the evidence on what we have discovered, these are big crimes against humanity," and that term spills out of the Nuremberg Code, by the way.

Patrick Wood:

Most generally, the actors that have been involved with the great pandemic that we've had in the last two years, we believe that there is a great case to be made that indeed crimes against humanity have been committed in the same context and sense that they were discovered at the Nuremberg trials that produced the Nuremberg Code, which is now embedded in every nation on earth and their legal system and in our country and every state as well. It's interesting to find out.

Patrick Wood:

Medical experimentation is verboten, period, and yet it has happened anyway with no informed consent along the way, and shots going into the arm and stuff happening and people getting sick and dying and the old drill, "What went wrong?" We're presenting this case to the American public in person, and I will say the dynamic of talking to a live audience today is a breath of fresh air for me, personally. I think everybody else would say the same thing.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

How many people are at your events and how many-

Patrick Wood:

It's been horrible. It's been horrible.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

What do you mean horrible?

Patrick Wood:

Well, the attendance has just been in the tank. We expected, we had hoped there would be 1,500 to 2,000 people at each event, but it hasn't turned out that way. We've had a couple hundred,

typically, and that's probably going to increase as we go on, but it has underperformed our expectations at this point. But nevertheless, I will say this, the quality of people who have been there has been astounding and we've made some great connections, made some great new contacts and stuff with people that we would not have otherwise met.

Word is getting out that this is serious business right now. Of course, we're competing with all these other things going on as society right now, the economy's about ready to roll into recession, you've got the stock market about ready to fall into a bear market, officially. Lots of volatility everywhere you look, and still, there's a lot of uncertainty about our mask coming back. It's COVID, whole wave coming back at us again. Are they going to give it to us again? You were competing with all that, too.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. Yeah. I wanted to dive into that aspect now because you mentioned it on your other interview, too, in that you warned people and I share these feelings deeply, I agree with you that this is a lull, it is not over. It is not getting better, and it is never, never going back to the way it was. We don't want it to go back that way because that's what precipitated this. I think it's a good point to give us your insights from studying to think for three decades and understanding the players and what their long-term strategies are as to what you think some of the next steps are.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

I know part of it is this digital identification of individuals, which started with the vax passport, which kind of failed somewhat, but still set the stage for it, which is going to progress into digital IDs. It's just going to then be the ultimate destruction of humanity, which is the Central Bank Digital Currencies, the CBDCs, which is coming almost every central bank is going to implement that within I think, three years, maybe five of the most, probably three to four.

We've got what appears to be disaster coming towards us, like a freight train. My guess is, and I suspect you'll agree that the past two years is going to seem like a picnic compared to what's coming.

Patrick Wood:

Yeah. This is the nature of revolution. If my hypothesis is true, that January 2020 was the coup d'état that started this war in earnest, the hot war, if you will, versus just kind of the leading up to it and everything. Lots of bad stuff happened from 9/11 through 2020 that we could point to and say, well, it looked like somebody's orchestrating this obviously, but man, it went into a hot war literally, globally as well on January 2020. Revolutions never stop with one attack. That's obvious, almost, I'm sure it's self-evident.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Sorry to interrupt you, but who is instigating revolution? Is it the global cabal tyranny that's doing this? I mean, it's clearly not the populace.

Patrick Wood:

No, it's not.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Because normally, when we think of revolution, you think of the American Revolution, so the patriots, who went over through the British tyranny, but this is the reverse [crosstalk 00:16:08].

Patrick Wood:

It is. What we have and kind of the clearest term, maybe to get across quickly, we have what's going on called The Great Reset of the planet, and The Great Reset that it's become a catchphrase. I mean, everybody's kind of talking about it. Most people don't have a clue what it means yet, but is promoted by the World Economic Forum, which is tightly interlinked and coupled with the United Nations. This elite group of people represent, in mix, all of the people that were originally in the Trilateral Commission back in the 1970s, same kinds of people, same agenda to transform the world into their vision, the way they think things ought to be. These are the people that have orchestrated this whole thing and they're the ones that are pushing it right now.

Patrick Wood:

It's easy to identify. Most of the people involved in this, you can look at the Klaus Schwabs and the Bill Gates, and the thousand companies that belong to the World Economic Forum, they all have CEOs, board members, et cetera, that are part of the World Economic Forum. It's pretty easy to identify them today. The idea that is of The Great Reset is complete transformation of society and individuals that live in this society.

The World Economic Forum is bold talking about both. They talk about this technocratic takeover on one hand, but reform society, that is the structures of society, the institutions, but they also talk, at the same time, about the restructuring of humanity itself. That is the merging of technology with human condition, with the flesh, the changing of genetic code, humans 2.0, humanity 2.0, H+ is another term is used.

Patrick Wood:

This is mad scientist type of stuff, Joe. It's like to the average guy on the street has never been exposed to this. I mean, are we talking like War of the Worlds or something that appeared on the radio back in the '30s or '40s and everybody freaked out? It's hard to get your head around how evil this whole thing is and it's all uninvited. Nobody asked for it, they just did it. They have just done it and it didn't just happen. That's another thing that's really important to understand this didn't just come out of the blue or fall out of the sky from outer space. This has been in the works for a very long time.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Indeed. It's interesting you say, mention that the – well, aside from the fact that it's been planned and when you say a long time and that's a somewhat nebulous term, of course, but it's at least decades, right? At least decades.

Patrick Wood:

It will.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

It maybe longer.

Patrick Wood:

Yes. I'll take you back purposely and intentionally here, I'll take you back to 1992. This was such an important discovery for me. In 1992, you remember was the year that the Agenda 21 was created at Rio de Janeiro. That was the genesis of sustainable development. That's where that doctrine was openly described. The Agenda 21 and the biodiversity convention that took place at the same time was the agenda for 21st century. It was foundational in the sense that laid out all kinds of stuff that's happening today, just nobody really paid attention. Of course, everybody called it a conspiracy theory along the way. If you mention Agenda 21, 10 years ago, you're definitely wearing a tinfoil hat. Nobody would listen to you, "Oh, that's crazy talk." But going back to that day today in light of what's happened here now, there was a great book that was released in 1994 called "The Earth Brokers."

Patrick Wood:

The two authors were scholars. They were also the original environmental crowd. They weren't on our side necessarily at all, but they went to Agenda 21, the real conference and good faith figuring that there was going to be some negotiation to dial back the development that was messing with the Third World and try to get the planet back together. They went hoping to turn some things around and they came away from the Agenda 21 conference completely disillusioned and they wrote a book called the Earth Brokers in 1994, two years later.

In that book, they criticized the Agenda 21 process. They started out by saying something like this, we argue that UNCTAD, that's the United Nations Conference on [Trade and Development]. "We argue that UNCTAD has boosted precisely the type of industrial development that is destructive for the environment, the planet and its inhabitants."

Patrick Wood:

We see how as a result of UNCTAD, the rich would get richer, the poor poorer, while more and more of the planet is destroyed in the process. What can we say, but amen to that? Here we are today, it's exactly what's happened. But they went on and talked about the biodiversity convention, which I said ran at parallel with Agenda 21 conference, same conference, same people, same buildings, that it just two different thought tracks.

They wrote about the biodiversity convention, which has become incredibly important today to the United Nations. They said the convention implicitly equates the diversity of life, that is animals and plants to the diversity of genetic codes. By doing so, diversity becomes something modern science can manipulate. It promotes biotechnology as being essential for the conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity.

Patrick Wood:

They redefined the term "biodiversity" for one, but they went on and said, the main stake raised by the biodiversity convention is the issue of ownership and control over biological diversity. The major concern was protecting the pharmaceutical and emerging biotechnology industries. That was their assessment. To which today we can say, "Bingo, that is exactly what happened

back then, and this is exactly the expression today that we see of the genetic takeover of life on planet Earth.” They've gotten the seeds, they've gotten the plants, they've gotten the animals.

Patrick Wood:

Now, you have people like the chief medical officer of Moderna, Tal Zaks is his name – never met him, but I don't know that I want to either. But he said, and this was on their website at one point. I think they've taken it down since. He said, this is Moderna, the prime maker and developer of the messenger RNA shot. “We are actually hacking the software of life,” he says, “we think about it as an operating system.” If you could actually change that, if you could introduce a line of code or change a line of code, it turns out it has profound implications for everything. No kidding.

Patrick Wood:

You look at this in the whole scope of things, from '92 on, all the stuff that's happened, the legislation has protected and isolated the Big Pharma industry and stuff. These crazy people were on the loose back then, and they pulled kind of the pre-coup, you call it that, they laid the groundwork for the coup in 1992, protecting the pharmaceutical and emerging biotech industries. That's what we have today, companies like Moderna making messenger RNA injections that meddle with the human condition. This has never happened before. All other species, everything else has happened. But now, the genetic makeup of mankind is in question.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

But the historical or the origins of this movement goes back far further than that, I mean, in the '70s, you got the Trilateral Commission, and then you talk about in your books and your presentation of how it goes back and even into the '30s.

Patrick Wood:

Absolutely.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

The origins in the United States and Canada, actually, you share how you did some interesting reviews because most of the correspondence occurring in the '30s was by handwritten letters on microfilm that you eventually dug up and read and digested and kind of understood what they were doing. Yes, why don't you just share that?

Because, I mean, you talk about it in the other one where you missed this, because the originators of the technocracy movements in the '30s got in some type of argument with the Hearst newspaper empire, which was the major empire for media back then, it was the media. Because of that, they forbade any of the writers to talk about them so it kind of got buried for a few decades.

Patrick Wood:

It did, and that's exactly right. What happened was Howard Scott, who happened to be one of the co-founders of Technocracy Inc., but he was also kind of the leader of the group at Columbia University when it was housed there at Columbia in 1932. He had promoted himself as being a

certified engineer and kind of one of the intellectual guys that would fit in to Columbia University. He wasn't from Columbia, but he was kind of heading the movement there at Columbia.

It was discovered while there that he was a complete fraud. He had no engineering degree at all. He was just a blowhard. He was a promoter, basically a con man, and Nicholas Murray Butler, the president of Columbia, who was a big name dropper and a big global in his own right. He flipped out, he just freaked and he drop-kicked him out of Columbia, summarily, "Out of here, don't ever come back."

Patrick Wood:

They occupied half the basement at Hamilton Hall at the time, it was no easy thing to get them all out, but he said, you're just, "Take a march right now, you're out of here." Well, by the same token, Howard Scott was out working in the media like crazy and he worked the Hearst empire to get articles about technocracy published all across the country.

When Randolph Hearst discovered, as Butler did, that he had been taken for a ride, and that his media empire had been manipulated. He freaked out and he sent out a memo, actual telegram-type memo. He set out a memo that every newspaper in the country said, "If anybody ever mentions technocracy again, you're fired." Well, it took care of that. The history books simply didn't have anything, when history has a 25-year lag typically.

Patrick Wood:

Historians don't go back and analyze stuff from last year to write in history books. They go back 25 years and they look around and they read the newspaper articles and whatever, and try and figure out what happened. That's how they write history. Well, there's this huge hole on the technocracy movement because it just got dropped out.

All of a sudden, there's no newspaper articles. It's just like they disappeared in a thin air. The people at Columbia were not talking about it anymore. The big, highly credentialed scientists and engineers at Columbia who were crowing about technocracy the year before, now, all of a sudden, would not dare mention the word for loving their money. And so, there was no articles on them and they produced no more papers or anything. It's just gone.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. It sounds like the equivalent of vitamin D, hydroxychloroquine and ivermectin in the 21st century.

Patrick Wood:

It does. I know. Anyway, it was no surprise, in a way, that the technocracy never hit the American history books. Although, when I did go back to look specifically when I finally got a bead, yes, it was real. Yes, it was at Columbia and so on, it wasn't too difficult to break it down, to figure out what happened. Then we discovered an archive, a major university archive at University of Edmonton in Alberta, where all of the leaders of the Canadian movement had combined their papers in the '90s and took them to the University of Alberta at Edmonton and donated the papers to an archive and they boxed them all up and asked for free boxes and whatever they do in archival studies, and they put them in the warehouse and they sat there for

years and years and years until it got published on the internet at the catalog, we discovered it and thought, dang, that's really interesting.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Jackpot.

Patrick Wood:

That's hot. My wife and I just hopped in our car. We drove right up to Edmonton. The weather was terrible, but we had to do it and spent a whole week there as they brought out cart after cart, after cart for us to go through and shift through and make photocopies and everything else of the original documents. We could break it down pretty good after that what really was going on.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. You have an interesting, relatively unique perspective on the origins of this whole movement towards global tyranny. What I'd like to diverge now, so what I mentioned initially, that prompted the request to connect with you is to help us understand the similarities in perhaps differences of totalitarianism and technocracy because it appears to be two different components, but maybe not. I mean, you're the expert, so what's your take on it?

Patrick Wood:

Well, it is fair to say that the expression of technocracy will appear as totalitarianism in this sense, the control over you and I will not be by a dictator issuing a press release saying, "If you cross this line, we'll execute you," sort of thing. That's the way dictators have worked in the past, I suppose. They make a proclamation and then they enforce it with their goon squads. The way things are going to be controlled today is through technology, through algorithm.

Patrick Wood:

This is a very important difference. There's not people behind it that you can look at and blame, or get your hands around their neck and say, "Don't do that anymore." The algorithm now can be, we can look at it in terms of a Google, some of the social media censorships going on, social credit scoring system in China, which has now spread to many parts of Europe, but it's coming here as well.

The so-called artificial intelligence boom has created the possibility of controlling people by algorithm, rather than by political dictate. There has been a battle between technocrats and governments ever since technocracy started. They hated back in that day, they hated government. They wanted to get rid of government. There is still that propensity today. You see it at the World Economic Forum, you see it at United Nations. They want to dissolve the national governments of the world. Historically, fascism and communism have been instituted by national governments, right? Like Germany, Russia, and so on.

Patrick Wood:

These entities are on the hit list for technocracy. We saw this, by the way, just recently, there was a conference in Dubai, it was called I think the global governance conference or something like that. It was partly put on by the United Nations and there were a bunch of financial mucky

mucks there. There was one in particular, I think her name was Pippa Malmgren, she's from America, but she's in Great Britain, and she does financial wealth management services for the ultra-rich.

You don't get her phone number and dial it up and say, "I want to buy some stock." That's not the way it is. But she gave a little talk and she was the one that talked about the destruction of the fiat currency system. And she said, "When it happens, there's simply going to be a change over. All the fiat currencies are going to go, and there's going to be an implementation of digital currency."

Patrick Wood:

But she also made [a] point in that same little talk that she gave in the panel that the nations of the world, the nation state structures of the world are declining rapidly now. They tend to measure this in terms to say, well, democracy, but that's not really an accurate barometer to just say, "Well, democracy is declining. Therefore, the nation state is declining."

I mean, you could have said that about Russia in 1918 too, ended up in being horrible, oppressive dictatorship. But the antipathy that I saw in her voice, that she's just reflecting what she saw, I guess, that the nation states are the target of destruction. They must go. If you look at Europe right now, it's pretty easy to understand how this happened in Europe. You see all the countries of Europe, just like you did a hundred years ago.

Patrick Wood:

You see Switzerland, you see Germany. Look at a map, you see Germany, you see Finland, et cetera. But because of the EU (European Union), the nation states themselves have virtually no power to do anything anymore. They can't make any decisions that are substitute for the country. They're all made at the EU level.

That's why a lot of people over in Europe call the EU a technocracy, they're a bunch of technocrat elites, they're unelected, they're unaccountable. Nobody can get to them and they're making decisions for everybody else. You can say, "well, the nation states are still there," but they've been stripped of their power. They can't do anything anymore. They can just make some social decisions about themselves, basically, that's it.

Patrick Wood:

We see the nation states of the world being reduced in power, and we see the technocrat elite being elevated in power, where you have companies like Google, for instance now, are often operating in the affairs of people within those states, with more power than the state house itself. This is the flip flop.

This is a very important distinction to make, I think, because these are not nation states, these new actors are not nation states, the Googles of the world, the Facebooks of the world, etcetera, all the big corporate giants and stuff. These are actors of a different sort altogether. They cannot be compared to anything that nation states have done in the past, like produce fascism or communism or socialism. This is altogether different.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

That helps a lot because it's quite obvious after your explanation that totalitarianism is actually an outgrowth of technocracy?

Patrick Wood:

Yes, it will feel that way. [crosstalk 00:36:03]. It'll feel like totalitarianism.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. In support of what you just said, that's going on right now as we speak is that the World Health Organization has put out this request or petition, or I'm not sure exactly what it's called, but the governance for control of the entire global response to any future pandemic that they have the authority to define what the pandemic is.

Like they haven't perverted the definition at least a few times since they've been involved, but it's under their complete control of what the definition is of what a pandemic is. They control the responses, not any sovereign nation. From what it appears, in my review, and if the president doesn't hit the authority to sign this, it has to be ratified by two-thirds of the Senate, which seems to be unlikely, but who knows how they can pervert the legal system to make this, to enact this craziness. But it seems that's the way, that's the current-day application of what you just said.

Patrick Wood:

That's right.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Removal of the sovereign states.

Patrick Wood:

It's very clever how they're going to do this, I'm sure. I don't know all the details yet, but they have ways to get stuff through different countries because they want everybody on board. They call it being inclusive. They want everybody on the same page. When we had the Paris climate agreement, for instance, that was framed as a treaty to everybody else in the world. It was framed as an agreement. An agreement in the United States only needs 50% passage in the Senate, not two-thirds. That lowered the barrier right there, and it makes it almost guaranteed it's going to pass.

Patrick Wood:

But nevertheless, there was a trigger put into the treaty part of it, where if a certain percentage of nations signed the agreement, then it would become binding for everyone. President Obama went to China and he signed the agreement in China with the Chinese premier. It was enough to pull the trigger, the binding part of the Paris climate agreement, not everybody in the world. This is very sneaky, nobody saw that coming. I expect that we'll be surprised by how they implement this, but you know what their objective is, obviously is to control everything.

Patrick Wood:

If you look at it in the context of what we talked about initially about the takeover genetic material on earth, this is the dangerous payload that we face. It's not just the governance part of it. It's not just the scientific dictatorship part of it where people now can be manipulated in doing things that don't want to do. But we're talking about the direct takeover of the human genome. This is a level, this is an order of magnitude of the problems that we're talking about with global governance. Takeover of the human genome, this is an incredible thing because that means, potentially, that our genome of humanity could be changed.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Well, will be, it's inevitable. We have the technology through CRISPR, to this initiate that now. I mean-

Patrick Wood:

Yeah.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

-there's no question about it, but I still think it's down the road. I want to diverge now is this, because I think that is a longterm problem, it certainly should be on the radar. But my guess, my suspicion is that things are going to be much, much worse before they are able to implement that level. They're just not going to have the time to do it because it's going to take years. On that note, Mattias was really clear in differentiating between dictatorships or monarchies like kings and queens that literally can go on for centuries as long as that dictator is benevolent and has the interest of the people at heart.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

It could go. Now, it frequently doesn't happen because their descendants get greedy and they screw things up, but unlike a dictatorship, a totalitarian regime, invariably, inevitably self-destructs. Now, interestingly, and this kind of confluences with the technocracy. I didn't realize this, but there has been no totalitarian regimes prior to the 20th century. It seems like they need a technocratic base or foundation to implement the totalitarianism, which is in absolute alignment with what you just said.

Patrick Wood:

Yes. Exactly.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Okay. Having said that, the self-destruction, here's my concern, one of the primary reasons I wanted to have you dialogue about this is if they're going to self-destruct, you've got so many – we can go on a tangent site, I mean said, people who are involved in this are known, well, some of them are known, my guess is that the bigger players are hidden because they've got wealth that makes Gates and Bezos and Musk look like they're not even in the game, they're rounding there.

The people with the real wealth are probably behind this and they've got this totalitarian regime, it's going to self-destruct and they're in over their head. They're playing a game they've never played before, and they don't have any concept of the unintended consequences that they're going to initiate.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

There are many resources I've connected with and people I've listened to who are fairly convinced that something like a World War III is coming. It's not just with this Ukraine, but it could be absolutely unrelated to that, but some type of world event that may take out, at least, one-third of the population, maybe up to three-fourths of the humanity may go. We're talking 2 to 5 billion people gone within a few years.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

If that happens, almost everything we're talking about, like just genetic editing of the human genome, becomes irrelevant. I mean, we essentially go back 300 years, I would think, if that happens. I mean because every supply chain will be decimated, I don't know if the internet will still be up. It could be, but it depends on the amount of decimation that occurs. One, this is what I really wanted to talk about, and I'm glad we've had the preface for this, but I'm sure you've considered this. I really want to get your perspective on what I just said.

Patrick Wood:

Yes. Yeah. This is one possible outcome. No question about it that the World War III or a world war is going to be triggered. It's not in the best interest, for instance, the World Economic Forum to have a world war. But that doesn't mean it won't happen either.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Unintended consequence.

Patrick Wood:

They could be stepping at it. So far, I think that the Ukraine war is pretty orchestrated and scripted in many ways to the agenda of the World Economic Forum. But it doesn't mean it couldn't lose control and the thing just goes nuts. If that happens, I don't know where I put that on the doomsday clock of that happening. I'm not really sure, but it is definitely a possible outcome.

If it does happen, it will spoil everything for everyone for a very long period of time. As the Bible says, it'll take seven years to go through the countryside and bury all the radioactive bones. That'd be very ugly.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, I'm not convinced it's going to be a nuclear conflagration.

Patrick Wood:

Yeah, it may not be.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

But it could be, but they have the technology, I mean, just look what they can do by launching these pandemics and these bioweapons.

Patrick Wood:

Yes, bioweapons.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

I mean, COVID was a joke. I mean, it was essentially not much more than a flu. Yeah, it killed a few million people, maybe, and probably 10 times that, and the people who got the jab, well, maybe 100 times that will die from those who got the jab. I'm convinced that the vast majority of people who were jabbed are going to be dead at some point. This is a direct consequence of that injection. I'm pretty convinced of that. There's some powerful evidence to support that.

I'm glad it wasn't sooner rather than later, because they could have actually dropped like flies of ADEs, antibody-dependent enhancement reactions, this last winter, but they didn't, but it's definitely set the stage. I was a Boy Scout, almost made Eagle, but I kind of started too late, so I didn't get there. But the Boy Scouts motto was to be prepared.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

I just think it's for the 10% of us who have not been, who still have our critical thinking skills, it just seems in my mind, it's best to prepare for contingency like this. That means you are out of every big city, because it's going to be gone, every big city, every big urban area, you cannot survive in an urban area. It's got to be a real rural area where you have a big community. And ideally, it's not even in the U.S., you're out of the U.S.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

I mean, that's my conclusion, but feeling at this point that the things are just kind of what we said earlier, and I think we're both in agreement, it's going to get much worse and we have no idea. It could be monkeypox it could be hemorrhagic fever virus that they unleash at us, who knows? But it's going to be bad. That may be, that may take out a half of the population world. I don't know, or it's a world war or a combination of the two, but something is going to kill a critical amount of people that will just collapse all the supply chains. Then you're on your own, you are absolutely on your own.

Patrick Wood:

I think, yep, of the possibilities we have in front of us, war's one, another is a complete financial system failure.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

That's inevitable. That's almost guaranteed.

Patrick Wood:

That's right. It would drive the Central Bank Digital Currency system. It's important to note, most people don't really get this subtlety, but if our federal reserve is allowed to create its own

Central Bank Digital Currency, CBDC, what it means is, is that American citizens for the first time ever will be able to actually have a bank account at the fed. That's never happened before, purposely. If all of a sudden, consumers are going directly to the fed to deal with our digital currencies, that will mean that the treasury is completely obsoleted. It'll push our treasury out of the way, if they give up that right to coin currency, commit currency, that'll be pushed out of the way.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Which totally unconstitutional, it's unconstitutional.

Patrick Wood:

That's right. Secondly, the Congress will lose complete control of the creation of coin of defining coinage and weights and measures, et cetera. Congress will be out of it. The Treasury will be out of it now, they'll be completely obsolete and shoved off to the side. And that means that our entire economic system will be taken over by the federal reserve because whoever controls the money controls the economic system, period. This is a consequence that's going to probably come along with the CBDC when they finally happen and they all be interchangeable-

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

That's three to five years, three to five years.

Patrick Wood:

That's right.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

I'll guarantee you.

Patrick Wood:

It's a slated right now, three to five years. It's probably going to happen. Another thing that can happen. Again, we're just talking about waves of attack of things that could bring us down and bring about this Great Reset Klaus Schwab is looking for, is some type of a cyberattack. Now, this has been in the news a lot lately, a cyberattack could be a false flag operation, doesn't really matter what it is, whether it is or isn't, but some big thing, like taking down, say, taking down the power grid in Texas, or taking down JPMorgan Chase, all the bank tellers go blank.

Patrick Wood:

Nobody get their money out for a period of a week, stuff something like that, would again, put the fear of God into everybody. And they go, "Oh my gosh, do I need to wear a mask now or what? What do I do? What do I do?" We'll be back to the fear/panic, we'll do whatever you say to get safety, etcetera. It will perpetuate the takeover, the coup that we're looking at. There's two other possibilities near term that are very real.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

I think Gates has talked about the cyberattack so anything that Gates talks about has a high probability of happening because he shows his hand before it's played.

Patrick Wood:

Yes, exactly. We've got different scenarios right now, but we know where this group of technocrat actors are going. We understand their mindset, their philosophy, if you will, I hate to even call it that, but what is in their head? There's no passion, there's no compassion, there's no love, there's no mercy, there's no grace, there's nothing like that. It's completely an inhuman endeavor to capture mankind into a scientific dictatorship. The likes of which the world has never seen before.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. The extent, they've seen similar things, but not to the extent that's coming.

Patrick Wood:

Yes, not to this extent.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

The massive, the massive.

Patrick Wood:

That's right.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Billions, billions of people.

Patrick Wood:

Yes.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Not millions, billions.

Patrick Wood:

That's right. But let me lay over some of what Desmet says now.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Okay, go ahead.

Patrick Wood:

I've listened to him for some time as you have, I know too, and I know there's some-

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Did you like my interview with him?

Patrick Wood:

I did. Absolutely. I know there's some psychiatrists that disagree with Desmet and I just kind of discard that because it speaks to me. I understand it, right?

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. Yeah. Yeah.

Patrick Wood:

It makes common sense. I'm sure, I don't want to insult him by saying it makes common sense, but to me, it does. I'm sure that he [crosstalk 00:51:10].

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

If you still have your critical thinking skills.

Patrick Wood:

That's right. He's got textbook on it. Not simple, he would say, but you know how he came up to this point. But to me, it's pretty simple to understand it. One of the things that really impressed me personally, when he kind of was first rolling this out, whatever, last year or sometime, was that he was talking about the cultural issues with Germany and with Russia, what happened with the genocides there, the Holodomor.

When he brought up the point that the mass formation side of things always has to create a scapegoat. The scapegoat has to be there to blame policy failures on, because they can't do anything that's going to work, of course, because they're out of their mind. When things go wrong, they have to have a scapegoat because it can't be their fault.

Patrick Wood:

It has to be somebody else's fault so they build a scapegoat and we looked at the scapegoats of history and we look at the scapegoats today. We've got still a pandemic of the vaccinated. We've got all the outliers, the people like you and I who don't believe the official narrative, but the scapegoat is being rapidly created today, I think, all around the world, like never before in history, this is a global thing. He got real quiet at the end of it and I know he is a pensive type of a guy. I understand that, right?

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, he is. He's a good thinker. Right.

Patrick Wood:

You can just see his mind working to try and get the words out right. He said, the antidote to mass formation psychosis is free speech. He used that phrase, free speech. Well, I'm a free speech guy because I founded Citizens for Free Speech in 2018, right? I think about this all the

time. It caught me kind of off guard a little bit. I said, “Wait a minute, the antidote to mass formation is free speech. How does that work?” He got real kind of pensive and quiet, he says, “When the scapegoat is effectively silenced, that is when the killing begins.”

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, that is an absolute right.

Patrick Wood:

I thought, “Holy crap.” I see why we need free speech. If we are allowed to be silenced-

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Well, it's free speech, but it's two phases. It's the ability to do it, but to do it.

Patrick Wood:

Yes, that's right, to be able to connect with people.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, it's two phases, where you could have the free speech, just like you, it could be sunny out and you could be in a tropical environment. But if you're not going out in the sun, you're not getting the benefits.

Patrick Wood:

That's right. That's exactly right. We desperately need to preserve free speech in the world today. This is a universal concept. It's not just in America. Americans tend to be a little bit egotistical sometimes while we have a Constitution, we're really cool. We have a First Amendment after all, we're really cool. But I have found that free speech is a universal concept. I get emails from people all over the world saying so. We're being denied free speech.

Patrick Wood:

They understand what free speech is. It seems to be just an innate thing that people understand. They got a mind, they want to express their mind and they don't want to be censored or canceled. On a global basis right now, as the propaganda wars heat up and the attacks on the First Amendment heat up, we've got many of them right today, right as we're doing this interview, there's huge attacks on the First Amendment. Oh my gosh. The intent is obvious because the attack on free speech has come at the same time as the coup d'état started.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

It's required.

Patrick Wood:

It's required of these revolutionaries, of these technocrat transhumanist revolutionaries. They must destroy free speech at the same time that they take over the world because they have to control the narrative. The attacks on free speech right now are absolutely legendary off the charts everywhere on the planet. If Mattias is right and I feel absolutely certain, he is, because I can

read a history book as easy as anybody. When free speech is effectively silenced, that is specifically when the killing of the scapegoat begins. It's always the scapegoat that get killed first. There may be other groups that get mixed in with it just because, but the people who are the scapegoat are the ones that will be attacked by the mass formation psychosis crowd.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. Well, eventually if it's a totalitarian regime, it eventually eats its own children. It will kill half of its leaders and they will willingly comply because they are hypnotized, hypnotized, and they'll say, "Yeah, for the greater good, kill me." They'll do it willingly and gladly.

Patrick Wood:

I go back to original technocracy from the 1930s and when they defined themselves in their own magazine, which was called the Technocrat, that's an original name, I'm sure, they call it the Technocrat magazine. They defined themselves in 1938 as the science of social engineering. That was what they said about themselves. That technocracy is the science of social engineering. And they talked incessantly in their literature about Pavlov and BF Skinner and how they could control people and mold people to the economy, to the utopia that they wanted to build.

Patrick Wood:

They've had since 1938, at the very least, to be thinking about, "How do we develop the science of social engineering to be used against humanity?" I don't think we need to even think about it any further. We can feel it today. It's right in our face, every day, the so-called pseudoscience, I would call it. It's not a science at all, but they call it the science of social engineering.

They're using these techniques against the people of the world to manipulate them, to hypnotize them, to push them into mass formation psychosis. Somebody at the top knows exactly what they're doing with this. That's my point.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

A lot of it is the tech companies like Google.

Patrick Wood:

Yes, absolutely.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

I look at Google as a Skynet of the "Terminator" series with Arnold Schwarzenegger.

Patrick Wood:

Yes.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

They are Skynet, no question. They're probably the worst offender of all the technology companies that are accelerating this. I mean, they talk about social engineering. They're the champions, they own DeepMind, the most sophisticated artificial intelligence company on the

planet, which spawn off all these amazing programs that can be world go players and chess players like in minutes, but they're using it for nefarious purposes clearly.

Patrick Wood:

Yes, they are. It's clear. It's clearly social engineering. That's the bottom line. It's clearly social engineering. I'd give a shout out by the way, to Professor Emeritus from Harvard, Shoshana Zuboff for her book, "The Age of Surveillance Capitalism," I think it's probably one of the most important books of our century, but it describes what's happened at Google since about 2008, 2009, and how Google has transformed the entire nature of surveillance into creating us as resources to fuel their products that they're putting together to sell to the rest of the world. It's an amazing scholarly book that she's produced.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, I've written an article about that book and I've read it before too, but she does a good job of exposing it, but she fails miserably in my view on recommendations and action items.

Patrick Wood:

I would agree.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

It is just really bad news.

Patrick Wood:

That, I would agree.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Bad news on spades. I think, a better example is Robert Epstein, who is also a professor at Harvard and actually was the last student of B.F. Skinner and really understands this space incredibly well, he's actually testified before Congress a few times. I'm sure you know who he is.

Patrick Wood:

I do.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

He is really, I mean, he's not as eloquent as Shoshana for sure, but he really knows his stuff and he's a coder. He understands what's going on and he's actually compiled the evidence to show what they're doing, so great guy. I love Robert.

Patrick Wood:

Yep. But you're right, Google is at the center of it. They're the poster child for what's going on in the world today, but they're not alone. They just happen to be the poster child.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

All right. I think we've done a good job of covering this and I think what people would appreciate now is from your perspective of being in this for decades, knowing you've seen it coming for a long time, when would you start with this with Sutton? Was it in '70s or the '80s?

Patrick Wood:

Actually, 1970, late 1978.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Okay. Wow.

Patrick Wood:

Or I assume it's '77.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

All right. Coming up on 40 years, right?

Patrick Wood:

Yeah. It's a long time.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. You're definitely a veteran in this space. Having been involved for so long, you've seen it coming, it's here, which is the coup d'état you referenced earlier. This is like the final days. You are the big free speech advocate. You started your campaign or your organization in 2018. Obviously, that's a part of this, but I'm wondering if you could outline now what your recommendations are, and obviously, this is just directed towards the 10%, because it ain't going to work otherwise.

Patrick Wood:

I know.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

If you can still think and listen there, and literally, I would say a little less than half of my audience is in that 10%. It's like four to five times higher than normal population, but there's still, the majority of people are not. But if you're in that 10%, what can they do?

Patrick Wood:

Yeah, here's one thing we need to buck the narrative. Anytime you feel like you're being given a role to play, just refuse to play that role. Well, I don't care what it is, just don't do it. If they say, "Well, you need to wear a mask because blah, blah, blah," don't wear a mask. Just don't play the role they give you. Secondly, we have to-

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Oh, wait, let's stop there, because you got a lot of recommendations. Let's break them down. If it's something that there's consequences for not following the rules like if I don't wear a mask, I cannot go in and get my blood tested at the blood drawing center. Does that mean do you sacrifice like three minutes of wearing a mask or five minutes for the convenience of getting your blood drawn? And that's the case. I mean, at what level do you commit to that directive?

Patrick Wood:

I know, but there's a lot of personal choice here. I don't want to step on anybody's toes because you get in a situation like that, a loved one's in the hospital, you can't visit them unless you put on a mask, you get a shot, whatever, you got to make a personal decision on what it's worth to you to do it. I personally haven't worn a mask yet. It's cost me. I haven't flown an airplane for a long time. I didn't go a lot of places.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Well, that's changed. Thanks to Leslie Manookian. She filed that lawsuit from Florida.

Patrick Wood:

Yeah, I know. I absolutely love Leslie, by the way. She's an unassuming warrior.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, she is. Yes, who would have thought this small, tiny woman just comes out like a lion.

Patrick Wood:

Exactly. But she refused to play the role. She just said, "I'm not going along with this anymore." It's important to keep your mouth open, not shut. We need to reestablish human connection again. This has been denied us with all the social distancing and lockdowns and everything else. Get in touch with people, it hurts, I realize for a lot of people, because relationships have been burned up between children and parents and brothers and sisters, get over it, deal with it. You have to get reconnected with people again, because the future of humanity is in those connections.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Let's explore that for a bit, because if you – even if it's irrelevant, perhaps even your spouse or your children or your parents, that if they are in the brainwashed, the little brainwashed 30%, there is nothing you could ever say or do or show them to convince them out of that. They are gone.

Patrick Wood:

Yeah.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

They are literally gone that they swallowed the blue pill and they ain't coming out of it.

Patrick Wood:

Yeah.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

That's my assessment and understanding, and it's just an absolute waste of time. Would you refine that recommendation-

Patrick Wood:

Sure.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

-to connect to the people who are in the 10% or potentially could be in the other 60% where they're at least willing to talk to you about it. If they're brainwashed, there's nothing you can do there. It's too late. It's like, they've got the terminal cancer diagnosis. They're going to be dead in a week.

Patrick Wood:

Yes. The most important thing you can do, I think for family members that just don't go along with what you're saying, and they don't want to listen to you and they go plug their ears, la, la, la, la, sort of thing. At the very least, you won't convince them by anything that you say or papers you present to them, well, listen to this video, this will fix you.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

No.

Patrick Wood:

At the very least, you can continue to love them.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Right. That, we're called to do that. There's no doubt in my mind, a 100%.

Patrick Wood:

Just love them and forget the rest of it. They're not coming back.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

But don't try to argue with them. Don't argue.

Patrick Wood:

That's right. Just don't argue with them, that if you love them, I mean, if you have to love them, your children, it's a brother, sister, whatever, love them anyway, in spite of where they are. But it's also important to get with like-minded people and spend time developing deeper relationships with people.

Guys have lost the ability to have best friends, almost universally across the country. Women are better at having best friends, but they've been denied best friends because everything's been broken up. For some people, it may mean, look, get embedded in a local church and start going to these home fellowships, whatever, where people are meeting face to face and just talk to them.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

What's your take on the churches? Because there's a fair number of them that capitulated and surrendered and they've actually brainwashed themselves. What's your idea of the percentage of the churches that are in the 10%? I mean, is it about the same percentage of population?

Patrick Wood:

I would say, it's about the same as the population.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Okay. So, 90% of the churches are not a good place to go, well, then 30%, one-third.

Patrick Wood:

Yeah, some churches would be the wrong place to go. But the only reason I even bring up church at all, because people are there, right? And you can go actually sit next to a real person who's not going to pull out the meat axe and try and kill you on the spot.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Hopefully not.

Patrick Wood:

At least you've got somebody you can talk to and maybe you could give them a hug or maybe they'll give you a hug if you're lucky.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Sure, sure.

Patrick Wood:

Maybe you can remember the good old days when we used to be able to walk down the street and say, "Hi neighbor, how are you doing?" Sort of thing. We have to reconnect, Joe. That's all I'm saying. We have to reconnect.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

No, I agree. My belief is it's going to be not only have to, but it's absolutely essential and required if we're going to survive in the future. Because if you don't have a community, you're gone, you are a 100%. You will have to have a community. If you don't, you could be the best prepper in the world. Without a community, you're going to be up the creek.

Patrick Wood:

That's right. You remember when the lights went out in New York City several decades ago now, I think probably the lights went out in New York City and everybody around the country thought, "Uh oh, that's the end of New York City."

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Right.

Patrick Wood:

Because there's going to be complete revolution in New York City. People are going to be killing each other, because crime is bad or whatever. But when the lights went out, a funny thing happened all the people at night, they started coming out in the streets because they couldn't go anywhere. They couldn't see anything, so they come out. All of a sudden, for some strange reason, they started to cooperate with each other, they started to love each other and crack jokes and give hugs and "Hey, what are you going through? And how can I help you?"

Patrick Wood:

All of a sudden, there was this huge love Fest in New York City when the lights went out. Of course, when the lights went back on, it was back to business as usual, somebody got killed, 30 people were watching on the street and this person gets knifed to death. But it was an amazing experiment, I think, in humanity when there was real catastrophe set in, people all of a sudden, they naturally come out and they try to help each other and they do help each other.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

All right. Get into community, get out social isolation, which is one of the tools they used against us.

Patrick Wood:

Absolutely.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Actually, probably one of the primary contributing factors for the development of this mass psychosis is social isolation, so definitely do that, and with any other recommendations. Then, don't capitulate to the narrative like masks. I think better than example than the mask would be the mandated vax is for whatever reasons, like you're going to lose your job or something, listen, you can get another job, but you can't get another life.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

I mean, if it kills you, what good was getting the vax? I mean, you can stay in your job for a few more years and get your pension and retire. It's not worth it. It is a 100% not worth it. You just have to say no to that. There's just no other option, whatever it is because that is a non-negotiable, a non-negotiable, a 100% non-negotiable.

Patrick Wood:

Yes, I would also borrow a concept from the Bible that says always be ready to give an answer to anyone who asks for the hope that lies within you. That, of course, has a spiritual connotation from the Bible. But this is a very important thing. When you're out and about in your world, you should always be ready to meet mentally, to meet with somebody who is searching for answers. There are people like that. They're looking for answers.

When you run across somebody that just maybe got the shot and they have an adverse reaction and they're confused and they're hurt and they don't know what to do, you may have an opportunity to touch that person as such a positive way to help them. You need to be ready with answers, not just like, "Well, hey, give me a call" or whatever, or just say, "Hey, have a nice life."

Patrick Wood:

If you have the answers, you should keep them on the tip of your tongue. In your hand, if it's something written down, keep some stuff in your purse, in your wallet, your briefcase, whatever. If somebody asks a question that brings it up, you have concrete, tangible something you can give them. I know you've been doing that. You've been providing that material for people for a very long time. But a good example, I suppose a good example would be from your world. If somebody asks, "Now, that I've taken the shot, I regret that I took it. I'm really sorry I took it. I'm having all kinds of issues, trouble. What on earth can I do to protect myself now?"

Patrick Wood:

Well, I know you and other people like you have got some protocols and stuff that things that people can do and take that we will really help their condition and maybe will stave off some of the certain, some of the symptoms and stuff that they're having, be ready to hand that to somebody. If that's you and you studied some of Dr. Mercola's stuff or somebody else, whatever, and you've got some answers in your hand, for Pete's sake, cough them up and give them to people and say, "Hey, there's hope for you, friend. There's hope for you."

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Right. Because there's a fair number of people, perhaps even the majority of people who've been jabbed. It could be as high as the majority, but it's close. It's going to be 50/50, who regret ever having gotten it? Just because there's a jab doesn't mean that they're brainwashed. I mean, it's a good, good chance that they are, but doesn't mean it. If they're happy about being jabbed, then just delighted, then you just don't go anywhere. But if they're regretting it, certainly offering them resources, if they're concerned would be a good idea.

Patrick Wood:

But we do have answers. That's the point. We have a lot of answers and a lot of tangible things we can help people with. You need to do it, be prepared to do it. When you have the opportunity for Pete's sake, open your mouth and help them out. There's no percentage in just walking away and saying, "nah, that's your problem, not mine." That's almost cruel. If somebody's asking for a fish, you don't give them a rock. Just give him some help for Pete's sake. Say, "Here, read this," or "Go to this website" or whatever. "Here's some stuff, I take this, why don't you, you could do

this too, and it might help you.” At least, give them some hope, because right now the other side wants you to have no hope.

Patrick Wood:

They want to strip all hope away from you so that you will turn to the government or turn to the technocrats for help. We need to help people with this whole hope business and not to sell “hopium,” as some people call it, but to give them some tangible help on what they can do right now to put up a defense around their own body, around their own mind or whatever it might be. Maybe you'll never see them again, it might be, you never run into them again in the grocery store or whatever. Okay, so fine.

Patrick Wood:

If everybody were to take, at listening to this audience, if everybody would take that, this attitude and response and say, “I will do my part to give to anybody who would listen a tangible answer and something that can help them,” then you just be ready. Oh, you're always ready. You may go for a week and you don't give anything to anybody, but that one day comes along. Somebody you just run into, conversation starts up and boom, you know that, that's a divided point, but for you to pull out that stuff and give it to them and say, “Here, maybe this can help you.”

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. It's a form of speaking out really. It's ABR, it's always be ready. That process of connecting personally, one on one, face to face, is one of the most powerful strategies we have for increasing the number of people who are hypnotized. And that speaking out, it doesn't seem like because you're just one person. But if a bunch of people start doing this, this is what's going to take to prevent and stop them from going on these killing rampages, which historically has happened less than 100 years ago, less than 100 years ago, it has happened twice or actually multiple times.

But at least two big times in Germany and Russia where tens of million people were slaughtered. This time just tens of billions, if not hundreds of, well – there's no tens of billion, not tens of billions. There's not even 8 billion people. Well, it's billions, it's not tens of billions, it's billions that are lives that are at stake here. This is important, really important.

Patrick Wood:

It is. If we like it where we are right now to that big championship poker game, right? There comes a time at the end of the table when you have not maybe a good hand and you say, “I'm all in” and you push all your chips in the middle of the table, right? And if you lose that hand, you're gone from the table, you've lost everything, and you're gone. This is where we are as a world today. We, on our side, the non-mass formation psychosis side, we're all in.

Whether anybody else recognize that as immaterial, but we are all in, in this. This is the most important civilizational, existential thing that we'll ever deal with in our lifetime. It really is that important. It's not something we can just say, “Well, it's just another problem kind of like, well, we had a problem with Jimmy Carter. We had a problem with, what's his name? Slick Willie.” No, it's not that kind of problem. This is a bigger existential threat that we're facing right now.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

It really is.

Patrick Wood:

We must be deadly serious. But there's hope, I will say. And until it's over, it's not over yet, until it's over, we can make a difference and we need to try. We just can't say, "Well, throw up our hands and oh, there's no point trying, I'm going to go home and get drunk."

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

No, I think there's a great perspective and suggestion is that you realize that you're all in, you're all in. If you're not, I mean, you're going to lose it anyway. It's just like, why wouldn't you do that? Because what are the consequences if you don't? It's the same darn thing. You're gone. They're going to take you out. I mean, the likelihood is beyond – I mean, it's just a few years. I mean, the clock is ticking. The clock is ticking. You need to understand that.

Patrick Wood:

Well, Klaus Schwab told you by 2030, he said with his own lips, "You will own nothing and you will be happy," he says.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, well, I don't think, I really do not think we're going to get anywhere close to 2030. This is going to happen long before then.

Patrick Wood:

They're trying to make it happen. Yes, they are.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

They're accelerating this. I don't know what, but 2030 is a pipe dream, but this is going to – it'd be interesting, if it gets to 2030, I don't think it will. I think we're going to have decimation well before. It's almost seems to be almost inevitable.

Patrick Wood:

One of the reasons, by the way that the World Economic Forum has met specifically with the United Nations to speed up the agenda beyond or closer on this side of 2030 is because of the mounting resistance around the world to their agenda. I'm convinced of this. I've been watching this since the beginning.

Americans can't have 500,000 people in the street protesting anything, that doesn't happen here. That's just not our culture, but not Europe. In Europe, at the drop of a hat, you'll get a 100,000 people in the street, all screaming and banging pots and pans and hollering and carrying signs.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

It's interesting.

Patrick Wood:

You name it. It's like, they just wait for this. They got to all got their kids at home, make signs and stuff. "What are we going to do this week?" But they see this in Europe. I know they see these massive hordes of people that are saying, essentially like used to say in the Vietnam war, "Hell, no, we won't go."

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, yeah, yeah,

Patrick Wood:

This has to have an impact on them. I think that's one reason they're trying to accelerate the program right now and make it happen faster. To me, that's just kind of a little bit of a sign of resistance is working and this to me, this ought to tell resistance, double down, double down right now on whatever it is you're doing, double down on it, do twice as much as you did last week or last month and continue to put the pressure on it. And maybe, just maybe it might convince you to it.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

If I could share Mattias's recommendation is that to raise your voice and not necessarily in social media or anything, because you don't want to get banned or anything, but you want to raise it in face to face and people you know, personally, people that respect you. That, just talking, it just has to be a few people. That's all it is.

Patrick Wood:

That's right.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

But that is what's required, if we're going to stop this incredible destruction that seems to be coming at us like a freight train.

Patrick Wood:

That's right. I fully agree. I fully agree. We have some hope, we have some trouble, it may work out, it may not, but nevertheless, we cannot sit down and do nothing, we must do something.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. Remember you're all in, that's great advice.

Patrick Wood:

That's right.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

You're all in. If you're not, you got seriously go to sleep and think about this because there's no other sane, rational approach.

Patrick Wood:

That's right. Exactly. Well, I appreciate the opportunity to have this discussion with you. It's been great.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Oh man, this is great. This is exactly what I was hoping for because people need to hear this. They need to hear this need to understand the consequences of inaction, what's on the table here. These are really big stakes. I mean, it is not hyperbole to talk about existential threat to the race. It really isn't. I mean, at least the race as we know it. I mean, you could turn it back a few hundred years.

Patrick Wood:

I kind of like it the way. [crosstalk 01:19:41]. I like it the way I know it, right now, I like it.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah, I just don't think we're ever going to go back to that again.

Patrick Wood:

No, we're not.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

The likelihood is very, very remote. It could be completely dystopian or it could be kind of a utopian just going back to our ancestors' times. But one thing we can [inaudible 01:20:01] of it's going to change is going to change. And if you can participate in helping to change for the better.

Patrick Wood:

Exactly. Exactly.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Well, thanks for all the work you're doing. Actually, maybe if you could, in closing, you could talk about that tour that you're on, it's going to end in Tampa you're saying, and there's going to be an online event for that.

Patrick Wood:

Right. Right. The CrimesAgainstHumanityTour.com is the website. I'm not promoting it. I'm just speaking at it.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Yeah. Yeah. Yeah. Right, right.

Patrick Wood:

Like other speakers. But that's where you can find out details on the conference, what cities, where I think we're going to be in Houston and we're going to be in Minneapolis and Atlantic city, then Dallas and then back to Tampa, I think after that. The final-

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Okay. Well, it's good to end in Florida.

Patrick Wood:

Yeah. The final one in Tampa is going to be live-streamed and that will be available to everybody. And I expect by that time, our message will be so finely tuned and together, it should be our coup de grâce.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

What's the date for that Tampa, the last Tampa event?

Patrick Wood:

June 19th.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Okay. June 19th.

Patrick Wood:

June. June 19th.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Actually, Mattias's interview should be up around right around that time too.

Patrick Wood:

Good. Right.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

But yours will be up well before then this interview.

Patrick Wood:

Good. Yeah, that's good.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

All right.

Patrick Wood:

It's going to be an interesting time and we're just spreading the word. I'm really happy to be able to be out meeting with people face to face. That's something different right now for us. If we see

anybody on the trail by all means, come up and say hi and say, “Well, I saw you on Dr. Mercola's program” or whatever, it'd be great. Great to meet you.

Dr. Joseph Mercola:

Well, sounds good. You can go to crimes against humanity if you're live in one of those cities and attend the event yourself personally, which would be good to connect in line with the principles we're recommending to kind of aboard this, develop a community, connect with other people.
